2011

One day Pierre, the founder of Inwild, was telemarking with his cousin. Looking around at fellow telemarkers, Pierre observed that present tele bindings could be much better: be made safer, easier to step in.

An engineer by vocation with a passion for challenges, Pierre decided to create an innovative product for the telemark market.



2014

Pierre designs and constructs the first version prototype, putting them into the hands of his fellow telemarkers. Their feedback was so positive that Pierre decided to commit full time to developing the binding. More prototypes followed, each with hard progressive that are iteratively tested by a growing network of enthusiasts. The patent application for Meidjo is filed.



2015

During the winter of 2014-15 some modifications were made to improve the durability of the bindings. Called Meidjo 1.2, this evolution includes a reinforced springbox. Due to the growth of the business, The M Equipment started in Pierre's garage had to move to a larger facility in the South-East of France.

At the same time, Meidjo won the Gold Winner Award at ISPO. To satisfy the growing demand, an industrial process to produce the Meidjo was introduced. Further improvements led to the Meidjo 2.0.



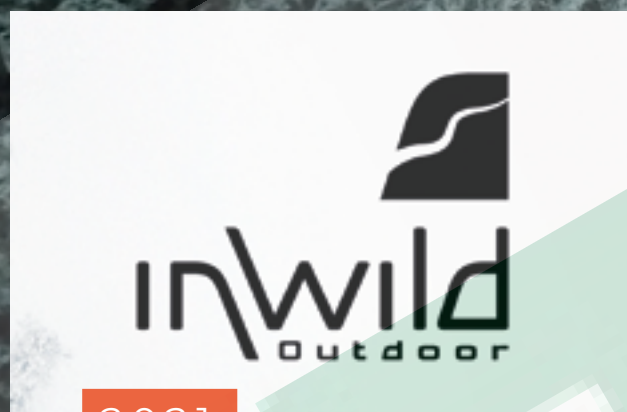
2017

After 3 years of feedback from the field, including World Cup tests, Meidjo 2.1 welcomes new features:

- New, more rigid spring lever system
- Ski-brakes can be fitted without removing the binding
- Incorporation of heel sets

2019

In 2019, Meidjo 3.0 is developed. It incorporates greater safety and an easier fit thanks to a new powerful and intuitive tech-toe system. In addition, agro-sourced materials were used to reduce our impact on the environment.



2021

Historically red, a black version of the Meidjo makes its striking in the range.

2022

The M Equipment brand changes its name to Inwild. New projects currently under development and environmental ambitions require us to seek proximity to snow-covered slopes.



2023

Inwild moves its offices to the Grenoble region to be closer to the snow-covered peaks, much to the team's delight.

Employees can test Inwild products and enjoy the mountains all year round.

As part of its ongoing evolution, Inwild has further enhanced the safety of its bindings with a new heel set designed to guarantee heel release under pressure and in the most extreme conditions. The Meidjo 3 SR (Safe Release) has been very well received by ambassadors.

# OUR ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITMENTS

## THE IMPACT OF THE BINDINGS

From the company's inception in 2014, we have integrated eco-design principles into our products. Since 2020, we have been measuring the environmental impact of each solution and making our choices accordingly.

We are supported by experts and the Pôle Eco-conception, with the backing of ADEME, in a virtuous process of continuous improvement.



In our design choices, we pay particular attention to the environmental impact of materials, and to where they come from. We give maximum priority to know-how from the Alpine Arc, and work with our suppliers to minimize waste and energy consumption in the manufacturing process.

To extend the life cycle of our products, we have made them 100% dismantlable and repairable.

Our eco-design approach also applies to the packaging of our products and spare parts. We banish single-use plastic packaging in favor of cardboard containers, or recycled fabric bags that find new uses in outdoor activities. All our packaging is designed to be recycled through current channels. We always try to avoid over-packaging.



## AFTER-SALES SERVICE AND WARRANTY

Inwild is a company that places customer satisfaction at the heart of its priorities. We support our customers at every stage of their purchasing experience, offering rapid responses to their queries as well as expert advice on equipment selection and assembly. What's more, Inwild is committed to repairing all equipment, whether under warranty or not, as quickly as possible, while






keeping financial costs and environmental impact to a minimum.

The choices we make on a daily basis are documented, and we measure them to continually improve and take pride in the decisions we make.

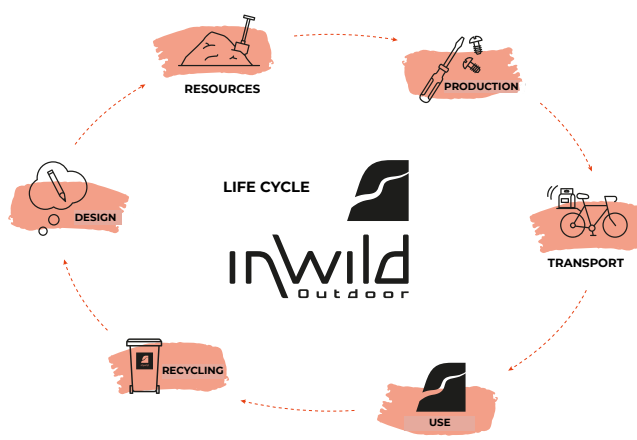

By privileging local partners, Inwild participates in the dynamization of the French economy and in the maintenance of a high tech industry.

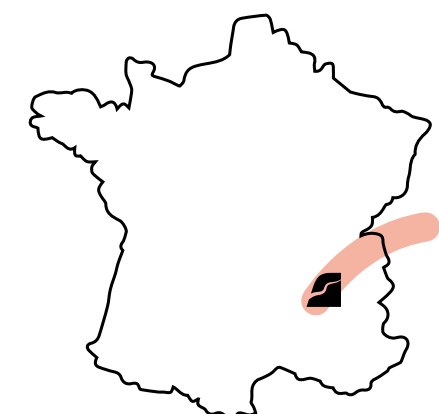
We imagine, design, develop, manufacture and assemble all our products in France, from the origins of the Meidjo telemark binding to the Linea touring binding.

Since 2017, we have been working with an Establishment or Service for Assistance through Work - ESAT. This establishment is dedicated to a cause close to our hearts :

ESAT helps disabled people to return to work. Initially, we contacted the ESAT to carry out a single assembly task. As confidence grew and we wanted to go further, we gradually entrusted them with more complex tasks. Today, a team of 5 people work on the Meidjo, ski-brakes and other accessories.



In our workshops, we prepare the tools and components needed to assemble the products. Then we deliver everything with the manufacturing instructions.

In the ESAT a workshop around our products has been developed, a stock location is naturally identified and our procedures are applied.

The finished product is then checked in the Inwild workshops.

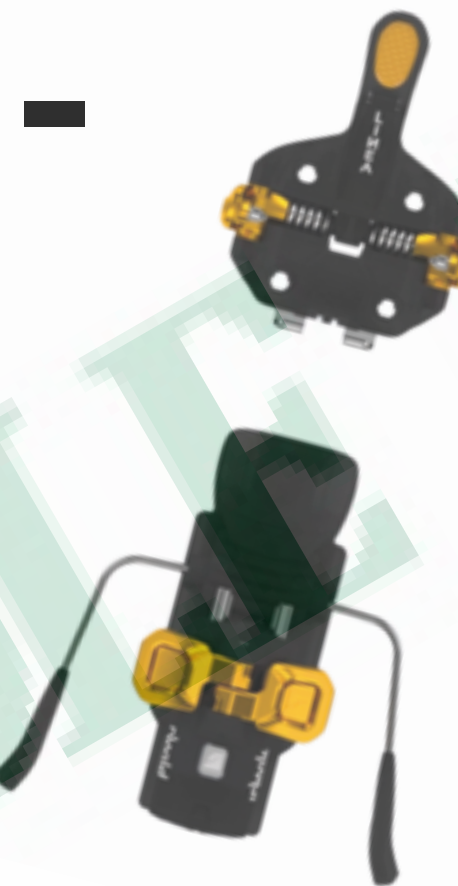

Linea ski brakes are automatic and retractable. They lock with a quarter-turn to the right or left. They guarantee the safety of your practice, whether you're touring or on the slopes.

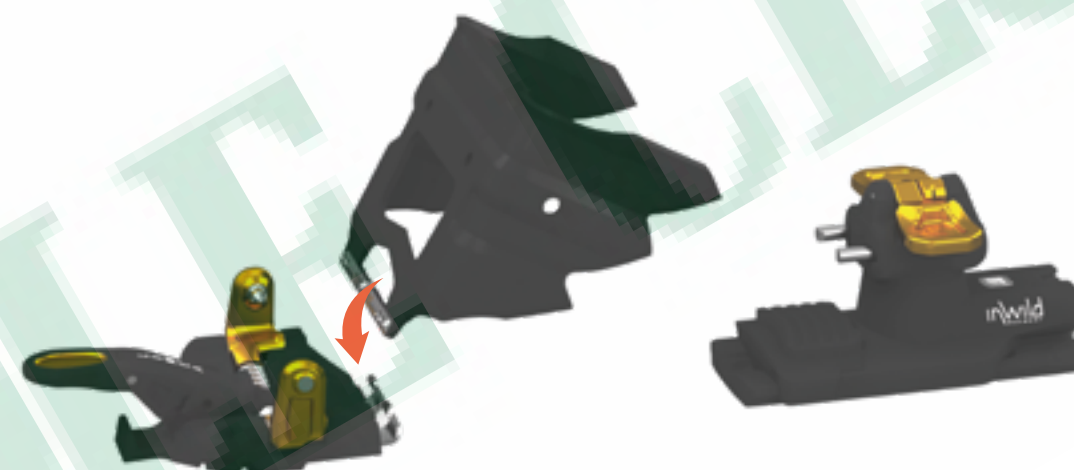

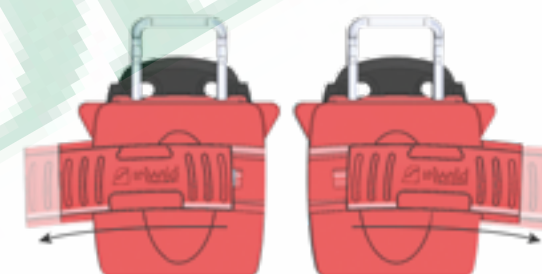

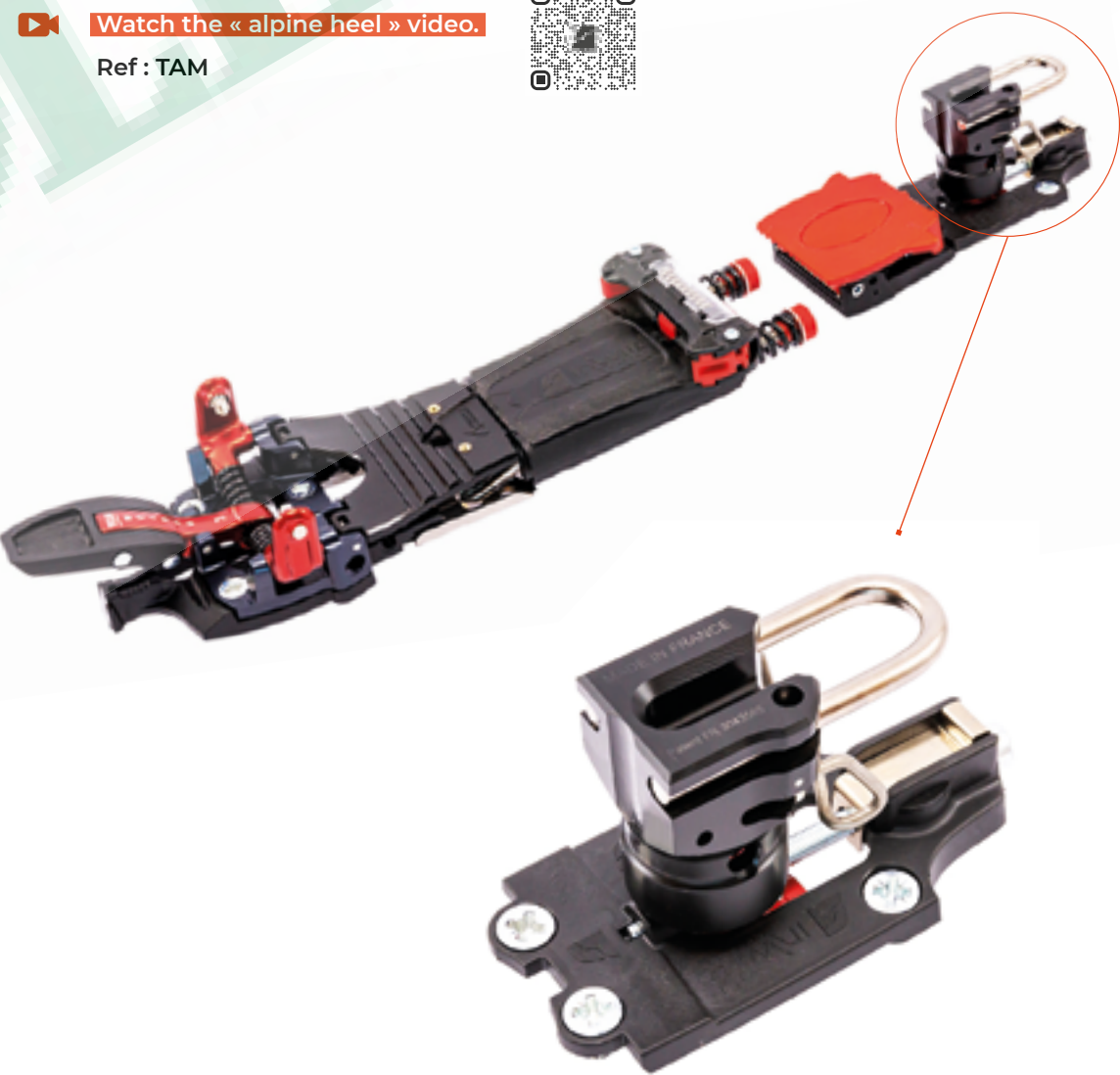

 The touring mode imposes the use of the low riser.
